Limitations:

System of play

**Progressive knock-out system - Double-elimination with playing out all the places.

- ✓ Winners continue to play other winners (main draw) until the final match to detect a champion (same as normal knock-out system)
- ✓ Losers continue to play other losers (minus draw for the 3rd place)
- ✓ Losers in the first round continue to play against other losers of the first round, the winner of each match plays against losers of the second round of main draw, etc.
- ✓ Losers of the minus draw continue to play other losers of the minus draw for the places.



Prizes:

The organizer awards several special medals and trophies in different competition groups and classes.

COVID 19 TEST & RESTRICTIONS

Before arrival:

All participants should be tested negative for Covid 19 on PCR test within 72 hours before arriving to Estonia.

The electronic declaration of health for those arriving in Estonia must be filled before the actual arrival to Estonia. You can fill the declaration 72h before the arrival. This makes border crossing smoother and people do not have to stand in line to fill out a declaration on paper. The confirmation of the border crossing declaration sent to your e-mail may be asked on the border or by the airline company. You can show it electronically or print it out before your travel.

No PCR test will be conducted except if needed (in case of doubt concerning one of the participant)

Viimsi Open International Table Tennis Tournament in Memory of Katrin Marks 17. XII 1957 – 29. IV 2016

Katrin Marks was one of the most remarkable table tennis players and coaches in Estonia. She was born in Tallinn in 1957. In her childhood Katrin did gymnastics and later got interested in table tennis.

Her first coaches were Helle Erik and Ottomar Kask. Katrin was talented and hard working. She became a member of Estonian national team in 1977. In total Katrin Marks represented Estonia for 25 years.

Katrin Marks was a six-time Estonian champion in singles and ten times in doubles. All in all, she won 52 medals in Estonian Championships.

In 1997 she started to take part in international veterans' competitions. In 1998 she became a world champion and a bronze medalist in doubles together with Kai Milvek in World Veteran Table Tennis Championships in Manchester. At North European veterans' championships Katrin won 8 medals, five of which were gold.

In 1979 Katrin graduated from Tallinn Pedagogical Institute and worked as a physical education teacher. At the same time she coached many young table tennis players. In 1996 she founded Nõmme table tennis sports club.

In 2011 she received an award "Estonia Learns and Thanks" for her contribution in sports and physical education.

Katrin Marks is remembered as a demanding but always supportive coach who encouraged many children to train hard and become better players. Her work is carried on by her daughters Mari and Mairi.
